

Seesaw

We are focusing on improving communication with parents about the children's learning. We would like to communicate consistently with parents about what is happening in our classrooms. Formal reporting such as parents evening and end of year reports gives parents feedback three times a year, but as a staff we would like to provide parents with more regular feedback about their child's learning. We have decided to introduce Seesaw, an online student digital portfolio tool. For an introduction you can view this YouTube video:

Parents/carers will be able to view the learning experiences that have taken place during the day and be able to see any comments the teachers or the children have made about the activities that have taken place. Parents will then have the opportunity to then discuss the learning with their child and post their own comments. This form of communication should further enhance the learning dialogue between school and home and further inform parents about the learning taking place.
