Context of the School

The number of pupils eligible for the Pupil Premium is above national average of 19% at 31%. The percentage of pupils on the SEN Support Register is above the national average of 17% at 22%, with 12% for Speech and Language The percentage of pupils with a Statement of Special Educational Needs is in line with the national average of 1.6% at 1.4%. Significantly above proportion of pupils 47% come from minority ethnic heritages and speak English as a second language. The number of pupils arriving and leaving the school since September 2015 is in line with national average.
